Wente Scout Reservation Willits, California

Session 1 - June 12-18 and Session 2 - June 19-25

- **EQUIPMENT LIST:** The [equipment list](#) will help you get your gear together for NYLT. Please bring your equipment in a backpack. You will be hiking with your equipment so a backpack and boots are essential. Be sure to **label ALL items with your name.**
- **TRANSPORTATION To Wente:** Be at the **Council Service Center, 1001 Davis St, San Leandro**, promptly at **7:00 am on Sunday of YOUR Session, Session 1- June 12; Session 2 – June 19** for check in. **Transportation to NYLT will be by chartered bus.** The bus will leave at 8:00 AM. **Note:** this is earlier than in previous years!
- **UNIFORM:** Plan to travel in full summer uniform that consists of: Short-Sleeve Official BSA Shirt, Shorts, Belt, and Socks. See the equipment list for details. Bring a bag lunch to be eaten after arrival at camp.
- **RETURN TRANSPORTATION:** **Return transportation is the responsibility of each Participant.** The closing ceremony starts Saturday **of YOUR Session, Session 1- June 18; Session 2 – June 25** at 11:30 AM. Be sure your guests arrive by 11:00 AM. See map for [directions to Wente](#). It might help if they bring folding chairs or stools, as there are no seating facilities at the site. NYLT ends at 12:30 PM. Please arrange your own transportation home after noon. It is suggested that guests bring a picnic lunch for you and them or take advantage of the lunch served by Brownsea Staff (see below). Your last meal at NYLT will be Saturday breakfast.
- Brownsea Staff will offer a **Lunch on both Saturdays** for the participants, families and guests for \$7 per person immediately after the ceremony. This is not a required meal but is offered for those who want it. We need a head-count and \$7 per person at Orientation.
- **MAIL ADDRESS:** Your name, Wente Scout Reservation, NYLT, PO Box 453, Willits, California 95490. There will be one mail delivery daily.
- **MESSAGES:** Telephone service to the Wente Scout Reservation exists strictly for emergency use only. In the event of such an emergency, your parents may telephone (707) 459-2110 and the request and return phone number will be relayed to the NYLT Camp. Calls will be returned as promptly as possible. Participants are not permitted use of the phone by themselves.
- **NO VISITING DAYS DURING NYLT:** Do not encourage anyone to look you up or drop in; time and schedule do not permit this luxury.
- **LEAVE RADIOS, TAPE DECKS, CD PLAYERS, PHONES, AND ELECTRONIC GAMES AT HOME:** All noises will be vocal harmony. At NYLT, you will hardly know an outside world exists. (The Course Directors collect batteries.)
- **DOUBLE CHECK YOUR EQUIPMENT LIST:** Be sure you have ALL required items, marked with your name. Backpacks are required. You will be hiking with everything you bring.
- **NOTE! LUNCH ON SUNDAY:** Bring a bag lunch to be eaten after arrival at camp. Do NOT eat it on the bus. Do **NOT** pre-make a sandwich with mayonnaise in it; adding mayonnaise from sealed mayonnaise packets, just when you are ready to eat, is OK. No lunch will be provided on Sunday by NYLT at camp. Your first meal at camp will be dinner.
- **COME PREPARED TO LEARN, SHARE, WORK AND HAVE FUN!** Your life will be changed at NYLT. You will want to absorb every minute of this greatest of all training events based upon Baden-Powell's original plan. **GOOD LUCK! GOOD SCOUTING!**
